As an introduction to the book *The Outsiders*, the 7th and 8th grade students participated in an activity to teach them about how powerful stereotypes are and how people sometimes midjudge others based on their outer appearance. The lesson began with a gallery walk where students viewed pictures of unknown people and answered questions about them. They made assumptions about the people based solely on their picture. After discovering who the people in the gallery were, they learned how incorrect some of their assumptions were. They will take this lesson with them as they crack open this classic, well-known book.
